The Chair asked if there were any members of the public who wished to respond against the application.

No responses were given from the members of the Public present.

The Chair invited the Applicant to speak about his proposed building plans at Cookes Cottage.

The Applicant informed the Council of his desire to preserve the character of the cottage and had employed a local architect to deliver that.

The Applicant had given consideration to the Teffont Village Design statement and the international dark skies status bestowed on the Village.

Councillors were asked individually to respond to the application.

Council were overall, satisfied with the proposed build plans.

Concerns were raised regarding the 54% increase in square footage.

Council asked for consideration be given to the roof windows and their size. Councillor Cordle asked the Applicant to consider reducing the size of the windows and to clarify the positioning of a roof window over the stair well.

The Applicant agreed to undertake to install black out blinds to the roof windows.

The Planning Application was supported by the Parish Council, with consideration to be given to the size and placement of the roof lights.

The Chair asked those against the Application 20/09049/FUL to vote: **No Votes were** recorded.

The Chair asked those in favour of the application 20/09049/FUL to vote: **Unanimous**

Proposal: Access improvements to form vehicle access

The public were invited to speak in support of the planning application.

No responses were given from the members of the public present.

The Chair asked if there were any members of the public who wished to respond against the application.

No responses were given from the members of the Public present.

Councillors were asked individually to respond to the application.

The Parish Council had a full discussion on the additional information provided by the Applicant.

The response from the Parish Councillors remains unchanged. They are unanimous in their objection to the amended/additional information for planning application 20/04714/FUL.

Reasons cited for Parish Council objections: -

- Teffont Parish Council continue to vehemently oppose this planning application.
- The Planning Application (20/04714/FUL) for vehicle access, still presents an unacceptable risk to traffic on the B3089.
- The proposed traffic sensor system will only sense oncoming traffic 50 metres up or down the B3089.
- The traffic sensor system will not detect traffic breaking the speed limit, and therefore. will not offer the protection alleged.
- The traffic sensor system offers little or no protection to emerging traffic when meeting vehicles breaking the speed limit
- There is no safe alternative for vehicular access onto the B3089 for this property.
- The only beneficiaries of the traffic sensor system will be the Applicants.
- Teffont Parish Council fail to be reassured by the proposed traffic sensor system
- The original planning application 19/07144/FUL (Question 6), states no alterations to the pedestrian access are required and requested vehicle parking for 1 motorbike and 2 bicycles (Question 10). Why has this changed?
- The property was purchased by the Applicant, with the full knowledge that there was pedestrian access only to this property.
- The access to Sunrise has been widened without the necessary planning consent and must be restored before building works commence.

 A site visit from the Enforcement officer would be advised. Teffont Parish Council request that any further submissions from the Applicant must be refused, as ample time has been allowed to revise this planning application
The Chair asked for those in support of Planning Application 20/04714/FUL to vote. There were no votes supporting the application.
The Chair asked for those against Planning Application 20/014714/FUL to vote. There was a unanimous vote objecting to the application
